Leadership development consists of **12 core workshops** (90-minutes each) that can be delivered as one-offs or as a 1/2 day, full day or multi-week leadership program.

HOW'S IT RUN?

A typical program will pick 3-6 topics and run weekly over 3-6 weeks or fortnightly over a trimester/semester.

Alternatively, a half-day workshop (2 modules) will typically run from 10am-1:30pm or a full-day workshop (3-modules) will run from 10am-3pm.

#1 STYLES OF LEADERSHIP

In this workshop, you will reflect on people who have had a significant influence on your life and derive how they were so impactful. You will learn about four-leadership archetypes: **CONNECTER**, **DREAMER**, **PLANNER**, **DO'ER**. Leadership is a minute-by-minute choice, and after this workshop you will be able to make an even more informed choice on how you want to lead in your life and how to thrive as a leader.

Learning Outcomes:

- Derive the principles of strong leadership from personal experience
- Describe the 4 leadership archetypes
- Explain how each style can be overused or underused
- Reflect on your areas of strength and development; identifying opportunities to maximize/teach strengths and develop/learn
- Apply the 4 leadership archetypes to your role as a leader
- Explore how the 4 styles of leadership can be used to help your education, personal life (health, wealth, relationships, etc.) and career
- Create an 80:20 action plan to put your biggest "ah-ha!" moments into practice in a tangible plan that includes SMART(ER) goals and support



We are proud that our work is intrinsically impactful and empowering to the students we work with. **We decided to do more.**

PROUD SUPPORTER: OZHARVEST



Starting in 2021, we began supporting OzHarvest formally as a **Proud Supporter**. This means that every leader who attends one of our workshops is making **real change** just by being there!

For every leader who attends, we donate 50c to OzHarvest, which provides the equivalent of 1 meal to a person in Australia who is food insecure. Since 2021, we've helped fund more than 25,000 meals as well as 'ride-along' with the OzHarvest drivers to rescue food and help deliver it to the amazing charity partners who prepare the meals.

CLEAN DRINKING WATER: CHARITY: WATER



Starting in 2022, we took our giving to the next level supporting an entire community project with charity: water, helping (over the next 2 years) to bring clean drinking water to more than 300 school students in Cambodia.

We've supported charity: water for many years and in sponsoring this project each workshop participant helps provide clean drinking water and sanitation.
